

BCSL Yellow Card Rule

5.6 Yellow Card Policy & Procedures:

- Coaches must report all red and yellow cards to the Athletic Director.
- Coaches of players who receive red and yellow cards will report the information immediately to his or her Athletic Director. The Athletic Director will report the information to the League Soccer Chairperson.
- It is the coach's responsibility to keep records. Any player who receives four cumulative cards will be suspended from the next scheduled game. If this occurs during the last game of the season, the player will sit out the first game of the following season. Only cards received in league contests will count toward any penalties. A Yellow Card suspension will not be enforced during state tournament matches.
- If a fourth yellow card is not reported to their Athletic Director and the player is not removed from the next match, the coach is subject to a suspension.
- Both home and away Athletic Directors must report red and yellow cards to the Sport's Chairperson.
- After the suspension is served, each additional yellow card will result in suspension from the next game.
